Sliding Door Options

Towel Bars: While it is extremely common to have towel bars on the glass panels, consider the following

- Might a towel distract from the beautiful tile selected?
- Might the towel be adjacent to a commode?
 - Some boys' ability to aim can be problematic

Barn Doors With Grids

Warranty: (As it relates to sliding shower glass doors)

Rollers:

- This happens as the house settles, particularly during seasonal changes from spring to summer and fall to winter.
- Many things in your house settle during seasonal changes.

Leaking Issues:

- Without professional installation, doors may leak.
- AG uses laser templates, considering every "to ensure a precise fit.
