GREEN HUE IN GLASS

The green tint often seen in glass is caused by iron content used during the manufacturing process. While some find this green hue appealing, others prefer a clearer look. To address this, low-iron glass is available, which significantly reduces the green coloration.

Over the years, we've observed that strong lighting within a shower—particularly when it's brighter than the surrounding area—can make the green hue virtually disappear.

Please refer to the attached photos for comparison: one shows a well-lit application where the green hue is barely noticeable, and the other demonstrates a setting with less lighting, where the green tint is more apparent.
